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About the Course

The nationally accredited Certificate II in Floristry (Assistant) is fun, interactive and includes many practical sessions. Students can photograph their finished designs for their portfolios and take their designs home. This course also includes essential retail skills.

Important Information

- Students must attend work placements.
- You will be expected to complete workbooks and will be expected to research botanical names and floristry aspects of flowers.
- Applicants will be interviewed to determine training needs. You may be required to undertake a literacy assessment in order to demonstrate competency at the required level.
- This course requires effective language, communication, and interpersonal skills to work with customers and others. You should be able to read and understand a range of simple texts and write a range of short answers. You should be able to complete straightforward calculations either manually and / or using a calculator. If you need assistance we can offer you language, literacy, and numeracy assistance beyond the course hours for an additional fee.
- If you already have Floristry or Retail skills you can apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). If you achieve RPL for any unit then you will not have to re-do it. Contact Rosie for more information.
